

CITY DEBRIS REMOVERDuties and Responsibilities

Under close supervision, performs clean-up work in vacant lots and parkways; removes ice and snow, and does laboring work needed as a consequence of severe and unusual cold, snow, and ice conditions and energy shortages; performs related work.

Typical Tasks

Cleans vacant City lots, parkways, and highways.

Cleans parks.

Cleans ice and snow from pedestrian cross walks and bus stops, and clears access to police and fire stations, hospitals and fire hydrants.

Facilitates refuse collection by moving solid waste from curbside to pickup truck.

Cleans debris and snow from catch basins and storm sewers.

Engages in "sewering" operations.

Performs other post-storm cleaning functions.

May be required to operate motor vehicles in connection with the performance of duties.

Qualification Requirements

1. There are no formal education or experience requirements for this position.
2. For some positions, possession of a motor vehicle operator's license valid in the State of New York is required.
3. There are certain medical and physical requirements.

Lines of Promotion
